**TO SPEAK AT THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA**

**Gainesville, Fla.** – Oscar-winning documentarian and best-selling author, Michael Moore, will speak on October 4<sup>th</sup> at 8 pm at the Stephen C. O’Connell Center. Doors at Gate 2 will open at 6:30 for students with valid GATOR1 ids, and doors will open at Gate 1 at 7pm for the public. For the safety of our patrons, no large bags or backpacks will be allowed inside the venue, and no video cameras will be permitted without Press credentials. Due to security and logistical reasons no tabling or signs will be allowed inside the venue. Moore is being brought to UF by Accent Speaker’s Bureau. Admission is free and open to the public.

A press conference will be held before the show at 7:20 pm in the Martial Arts Room of the O’Connell Center. Press should enter through a special section at Gate 2, with Press credentials evident. Deadline for questions is Sunday morning. Classic 89 will rebroadcast the entire event at a later date.
